-  Waste & Recycling Bin
-  Window Shade (no curtains are allowed)



## HELPFUL TIPS

Don't bring everything you own. Leave some things at home as storage in your room is limited.

Talk to your roommate(s) before you arrive so you can coordinate what you're bringing. You probably do not need multiples of everything.

Label all your belongings (boxes, totes, bags, everything) with your name and room number for move in. This time can be hectic and this will ensure that all items end up in your room.

Most first-year halls (except Genesee) have a full kitchen with a stove, oven, and sink on each floor.

Make sure you are covered under your family's home-owners or renters insurance. If not, look into purchasing some extra.

Single Room: 14' x 8'

Double Room: 15.8' x 14'

Wardrobe: 24"L x 36"W x 75"H

All Mattresses are Twin XL (36" x 80")
